Children across the country play with their American Girls dolls every day, but they don't typically get the chance to actually be one of the characters.

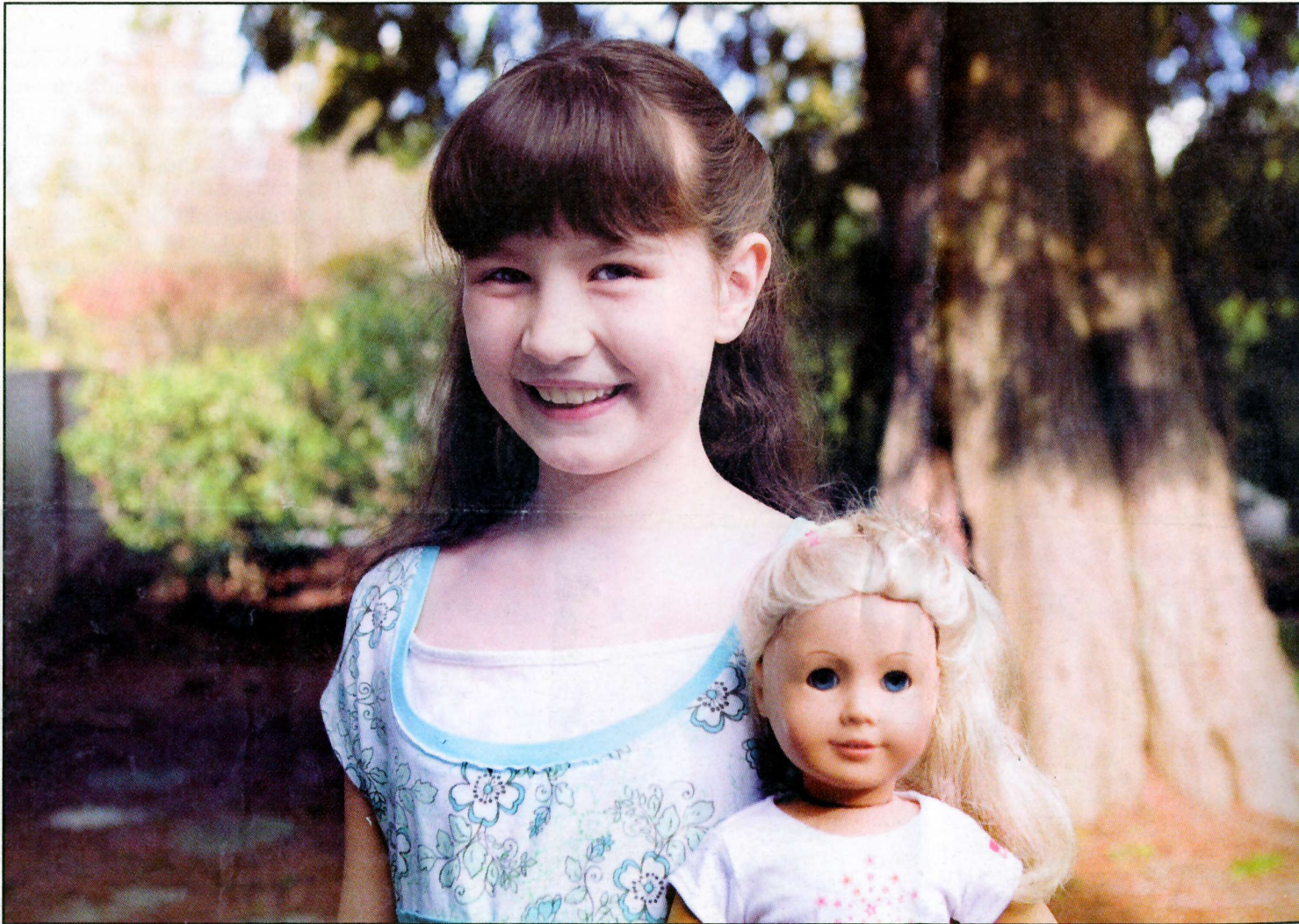
For one weekend, four Sammamish girls will do just that.
